This information can be a valuable tool for promoting occupational therapy as well as providing information for policy makers in both health and social arenas at national and European level. In 2017 the COTEC Executive Committee decided to make use of EUROSTATS census data for the calculation of occupational therapists per 100.000/head. Aim behind this change is to enhance data consistency.

COTEC Executive Committee is grateful for the support of its Member associations on compiling the data for the document and is pleased to publish the Summary of Occupational Therapy Profession 2017.
