OT-Europe Expert Group: OT with displaced persons

The group was founded after the OT-Europe workshop at the first COTEC/ENOTHE conference in Galway 2016. The aim of the OT-Europe project is to draft an information paper to assist in positioning the profession in the field. An exploration of displaced persons in Europe from an occupational therapy and occupational science perspective was carried out. Practice examples have been collected and incorporated in a website which will be launched at the ENOTHE annual meeting in Portugal. The core group had intensive collaborations with OT associations, Occupational Science Europe, practitioners, educators and researchers in the field of displaced persons and they all contributed to the work.

The products are an **Information paper** for internal and external use, a **Call to action** for internal use, a **website** with practice examples and a **template for national associations** to make an information paper on national level.
