

COTEC 30 YEARS 1986 – 2016

PICTURE POSTER COMPETITION

“COTEC Connecting OTs for 30 years – what will the future look like?”

This is the first announcement of COTEC Picture Poster Competition with the theme “COTEC Connecting OTs for 30 years – what will our future look like?”

The Poster competition acknowledges the 30th Anniversary of the Council of Occupational Therapists for the European Countries, COTEC, in 2016.

Rules for submitting a poster to the competition

All members of the thirty COTEC Member Associations are eligible to submit a poster to the competition. The size of the poster is A1 (594mm x 841mm).

The picture on the poster can be a drawing or a photograph. The poster can also have some written text, for instance a slogan, a heading or subtitle. The text must be in English. If the poster has any text, it should be sent in two versions – one with and one without text. The person who submits the poster must have copyright of the picture and the picture should not have been published before.

The poster should be saved in tiff-form (alternatively in jpg-form), minimum size for the short side of the poster is 2500 pixels. The size of the printed poster will be A1 (594mm x 841mm).

Each Member Association is to choose one candidate to represent the Association. This may be done by a public election within the Association; by a designated election team; or by the board of the Association.

The winning candidate of the Member Association will be sent electronically to posters2016@coteceurope.eu by March 20th 2016 – the preferred form to send the material is in tiff-form; alternatively in jpg-form, saved on maximum resolution.

COTEC will be in charge of the printing of the competing posters. The (up to) thirty competing posters will be on display at the COTEC-ENOTHE 2016 Congress in Galway.

The winner will be elected by a ballot vote during the Congress and the winner will be announced at the Congress Closing Ceremony.

First prize in the competition is a free ticket to COTEC-ENOTHE Joint Congress 2020.

COTEC will have the copyright of the final competing posters and COTEC will hold the right to use the posters and the pictures for COTEC promotional material and to publish the material on COTEC website.
